1. EDUCATION WORLD SURVEY 2020-21

We are proud to share that Salwan Public School, Ghaziabad ranked 9th in Ghaziabad and featured prominently among 2000 top schools across the country for its pioneering and progressive approach in Education as per a survey by Education World India Day School Ranking 2020. 14th Annual Ranking of Education world, parents, educationists, principals, teachers and senior school students in 28 cities and education hubs across India were interviewed to rate the country's Top 2,000 schools on 14 parameters of education excellence such as Academic Reputation, Co-curricular and Sports Education, Teacher Welfare and Development, Competence of Faculty etc.



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2. India School Merit Awards – 2019

'Salwan Public School' is Ranked No.1 in India under the Top CBSE School - Parameter wise for "Co-Curricular Education" in a survey conducted by Education Today. Out of 2315 Schools registered, the school has attained the topmost rank in the country for its pioneering and progressive approach towards sports and co-curricular activities.

The first step is to call for nomination and then collect the information ensuring legitimacy, actionability and unbiased nature followed by compiling a list on the basis of a set of list of parameters. Each school has to be exceptional to be counted among the best and we have done it.

3. Awarded as a Green School again by Centre for Science and Education

The school is awarded as Green in a Row by Centre for Science and Environment for constructing and maintaining environment- friendly campus through resource-efficient processes consecutively for a period of five years.



Out of 6622 schools, from all the states and Union Territories registered for the GSP environmental audit, only 172 could manage to be



green this year. The top ten schools of the country out of these 172 green schools shortlisted in the audit will be awarded in a formal ceremonial manner. It's extremely hard to reach that level but our environment core committee has made us proud by ensuring persistent practices in maintaining and sustaining the environment.

3. Brainfeed School Excellence Awards 2019-20

The school was awarded at Brainfeed School Excellence Award ceremony on 6th February, 2020.
